Donations to Clatterbridge Cancer Charity have funded a range of projects to help make this happen, such as bringing in new ways of treating cancer, bringing cancer care closer to patients' homes and breaking boundaries by becoming the first in the UK to offer certain clinical trials. We constantly need to fund new ways to provide these things for our patients. With your help, we can keep Clatterbridge as a place that stays in people's hearts.

Our £5m Research Boost

Each year, around 7,000 people die from cancer in the region and this number is growing so the Charity has pledged £5m over five years to take the ground-breaking research work at Clatterbridge to the next level. This will give patients at the centre unparalleled access to new, life-saving treatments.

Improving Survival Rates

Research into pancreatic cancer survival is more vital than ever, so thanks to your donations, doctors are running a scientific trial with Clatterbridge patients to better understand treatments and how to stop the spread of the disease.

Improving Fitness In People With Cancer

Doctors at Clatterbridge are working with patients to give one-on-one fitness coaching to help reduce fatigue, boost mental health and improve quality of life; a move that they feel could revolutionise cancer treatment.

The Healing Power Of Art

The Charity offers a range of creative activities, artwork and performances, including a partnership with the Liverpool Philharmonic to help reduce stress, provide distractions and help support people during their time at Clatterbridge.

Using AI To Improve Cancer Treatment

Thanks to £45,000 of your donations, we are supporting vital work undertaken by Dr. Syndikus to improve prostate cancer treatment using artificial intelligence. This research will help doctors nationwide to target the cancer more precisely, therefore reducing the chances of the cancer spreading.

Providing Vital Counselling Support

Each year 13,000 new patients are referred to Clatterbridge, and just as each cancer is unique, so is each individual's experience of treatment. You are helping to fund a third counsellor to provide support for patients who may be struggling to cope during treatment.

Taking The Stress Out Of Blood Tests

Thanks to donations, the Charity has been able to transform how blood samples are taken from patients with 'tricky blood vessels'. These vein viewer devices mean people can have their bloods taken much closer to home.

St Helens dad takes on abseil challenge to support local people with cancer!

Carlo Amadio took part in the Liverpool Cathedral Abseil to raise vital funds for Clatterbridge Cancer Charity. Carlo was diagnosed with prostate cancer in January 2023. His late dad had suffered from the disease, so he was aware of the importance of early diagnosis.

Carlo shared: "When I was diagnosed, I just felt empty. For a couple of weeks, I was just in my own little world but then I realised I had to make some changes and be positive.

I had so much support from my family and there is always support from Clatterbridge and the staff there. I want to give something back to Clatterbridge for the help they gave me."

During his treatment, Carlo had noticed posters around the hospital advertising the work of Clatterbridge Cancer Charity, including the summer abseil, but he wasn't quite ready at that point for a big challenge.

It is thanks to Carlo and all those who fundraise through our events that we are able to support the one in two people affected by cancer in our region.

Elaine's Story

"My name is Elaine and I was diagnosed with Primary Tonsil Cancer in April 2023."

"I remember feeling scared and in shock after hearing the news.

You never think it will happen to you. Even knowing that one in two people will be affected by cancer, it still doesn't seem real until it happens to you.

I received Radiotherapy and Chemotherapy treatment at The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre in Liverpool. One day, a young girl came into my room and played the flute. It was an amazing and emotional experience. I was having a tough day, but her music gave me the boost I needed. These small moments of hearing musicians play helped take my mind off cancer and the treatment. I was pleased to learn that these musicians are funded by Clatterbridge Cancer Charity through their partnership with the Royal Philharmonic Hall. It really makes a difference.

The staff at Clatterbridge were absolutely amazing. Everyone in radiotherapy took great care of me, and I felt completely supported.

I wanted to give something back, so I signed up to the Glow Green Night Walk with my friends. The year before, my friends did the walk on my behalf, and they all wore photos of me on their backs, which was lovely. This year, it was wonderful to join them!
