Here's all the information you need for this year's Glow Green Night Walk

START TIMES

The Event Village will open from 6:00pm for all participants, with music and live entertainment starting from 6:00pm.

The Glow Green: Warm Up will begin from approximately 7:20pm and then from 7:30pm you will start your walk!

All participants will be out onto the route, and enjoying their walk by 8pm.

START/FINISH VENUE

Chester Race Course, The Racecourse, Chester, CH1 2LY

Check-in will be located within the County Stand.

TRAVELLING TO GLOW GREEN

Chester Racecourse is located right in the heart of Chester City Centre so it's really easy to reach by bus, Park & Ride or train.

EVENT PARKING

There is ample parking across Chester City Centre, with Little Roodee Car Park (Grosvenor Rd, CH1 1SL), New Market Parking (Hunter St, CH1 2AR) and Linenhall Nicholas St, CH1 2NX) only a short distance from the Racecourse.

PACK COLLECTION DAYS

If you are reading this then you should have already collected your pack! If not, you can collect your pack from the charity office at Clatterbridge Cancer Centre Wirral. The specific collection days are highlighted on your ticket, which has been emailed to you -be sure to check the details and stop by to pick up your pack.

WALKER NUMBERS

Walker numbers are included inside your pack.

It is essential that you wear your walker number and ensure that it is visible throughout the event. This is so the Charity team can identify you in case of an emergency.

CLOTHING

We want to see you in your brightest and your best Glow Green outfits - think tutus, tiaras, temporary tattoos, top hats, tights - the bolder and the brighter the better!

Please remember to wear comfortable walking shoes, and bring a rainproof jacket just in case.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be open from 6:00pm. Please ensure you have your tickets ready to be scanned by the team.

When you arrive at Glow Green, head to the County Stand at the Racecourse. A member of our team will be there to greet you and scan your ticket. If you've forgotten anything, don't worry—there are stations available where you can pick up any essentials after you've checked in. Please make sure you arrive in good time to ensure you have everything you need before starting your walk.

GLOW GREEN MERCHANDISE

All merchandise will be available to purchase on the night, and we will be able to accept both cash and card payments. We have everything you need to make sure you shine bright on the night, from bunny ears to glow-stick glasses, woolly hats to tutus, you'll be ready to GLOW!

LANTERNS

If you have ordered a Lantern this will have been given to you in your pack for to you to personalise in advance.

Please make sure you bring your Lantern with you. You can hand it in to the Charity Team on the drop off point within the County Stand, after you've checked in. The team will do the rest you will find your lantern displayed at the Roman Gardens.

Lanterns are available to buy and personalise on the night.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Please follow all safety measures set by the Charity's Events Team throughout the event. You'll receive Event Control contact details for assistance if needed. Support staff, volunteers, and bike marshals will also be on the route to help.
