Baking:

- Baked goods should be fully baked and ready to serve.
- Recipes must be submitted with each entry
- Any Allergy Information must be clearly displayed with the bake entry if needed

Judging

- One vote per participant
- Baked goods are judged on presentation, texture and flavour
- If you are judging, please ensure you issue a vote for all entries

Organising your Bake Off

When arranging your bake off, the organiser must take consideration of the following:

- Hygiene and food safety during presentation
- Temperature control
- Cross-contamination risks
- Cleaning and sanitisation
